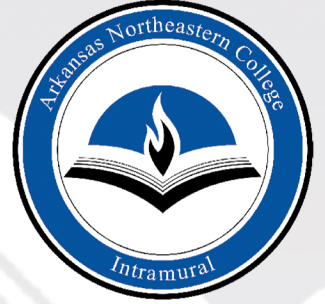
2018 ANC Black History Month Event

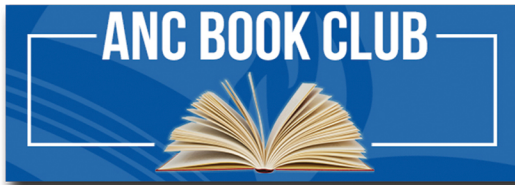
