




ANC Zoom Room

Due to social distancing guidelines, ZOOM OPTIONAL live seating is limited and will be available on a first come-first served basis. Students coming to campus to participate in a ZOOM OPTIONAL class that is full will be directed to seating in the newly furnished, comfortable space on campus called the ZOOM ROOM, or they may go to any other remote area they wish as long as there is internet access. ANC provides free Wi-Fi in many of its parking lots, so students may even sit in their cars to attend a class.

"Technology has really opened up new avenues for our students. They can take online or ZOOM classes from home, which can solve problems with childcare or even work obligations. The flexibility we are offering students should alleviate many of the barriers that students have faced in the past," said ANC President Dr. James Shemwell.



Student Support Services (SSS) at ANC Awarded U.S. Department of Education Grant



A grant of \$1.7 million has ensured the continuation of the Student Support Services program at Arkansas Northeastern College. The grant is awarded by the U.S. Department of Education and will be distributed over the next five years.

SSS is funded to serve 175 students per year. The SSS Program promotes the development of a college climate supportive of the success of students. SSS provides services to students from disadvantaged backgrounds such as first-generation students, students meeting the income guidelines or who have a documented disability, and students who have an academic need.

The goal of SSS is to increase the college retention and graduation rates of its participants and to facilitate the transfer rate of eligible students to four-year institutions. The funds awarded to institutions of higher education is used to provide opportunities for academic development, assist students with basic college requirements, and to motivate students toward the successful completion of their postsecondary education.

ANC received its first SSS grant award in 1997, and the program has continued on campus since then. In addition to free tutoring, the program offers academic advising, career and personal advising, and assistance in acquiring financial aid. Throughout the academic year, SSS also provides various study skills workshops to assist students in preparing for coursework and improving their grades. SSS participants also have several opportunities to attend cultural activities and transfer trips to enrich their college experiences and to afford them an opportunity to interact with other students outside of the classroom setting. SSS joins two other long-standing TRIO programs, Educational Talent Search (ETS) and Educational Opportunity Center (EOC), on the ANC campus.

The SSS staff would like to thank ANC for the opportunity to continue working with the disadvantaged student populations on campus. Likewise, thank you to everyone who was instrumental in helping with the grant process and to all the staff and instructors who continue to recommend the program to ANC students.


