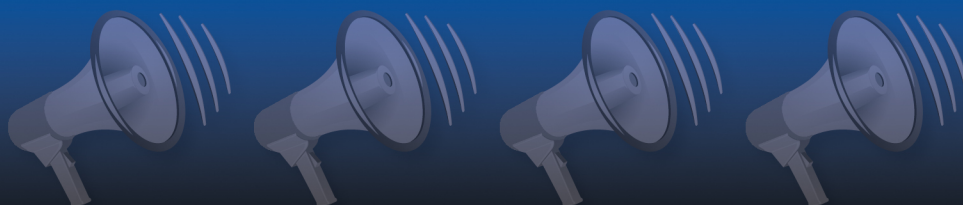
### Do you have an EYE on your vision health?

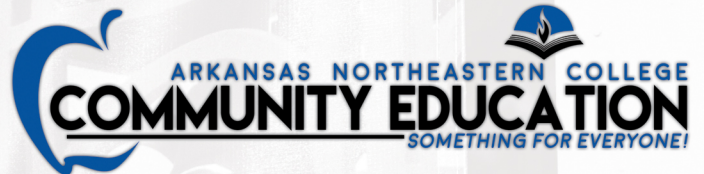
