It's important that we have the correct address on file for you to receive information about your retirement, payroll, and benefits. The change of address form can be found on the portal under Resources, Human Resources, and Handouts. Complete the form and return it in person to either Jessica Tippy or Tabatha Hampton.

### **Understanding Your Insurance**

Understanding your insurance plan is the first step to becoming a better healthcare consumer. One place you can find helpful information is your member ID card. On your card, you'll find the following pieces of information:

Your Member ID number
Group number or Division number
Rx categories
Your PCP/Specialist copay amount
Your Coinsurance % after deductible
Rx copay amount
Deductible


Before you have a procedure performed by a medical provider, understand what your insurance will cover. Your medical provider will be able to inform you of any estimated charges you can expect. Do you know the difference between urgent care and an emergency room (ER)? Going to an urgent care under your current health plan with BCBS is just a copay of \$50.00. If you choose to go to an ER, you are looking at larger charges that will be considered your deductible. You will be responsible for all of the ER charges until your deductible is met.
