

Men's Health Awareness

Generally speaking, men are at a greater risk for a handful of health conditions. Heart disease, stroke, depression, lung cancer and prostate cancer are at the top the list. Did You Know?

-Men are 24 percent less likely than women to have visited a doctor within the past year and are 22 percent more likely to have neglected their cholesterol tests.

-Men are 28 percent more likely than women to be hospitalized for congestive heart failure.

-Men are 32 percent more likely than women to be hospitalized for long-term complications of diabetes.


-Men are 24 percent more likely than women to be hospitalized for pneumonia that could have been prevented by getting an immunization.
