When ANC TRANSFER Students are out of ANC Financial Aid...

Please inform students it is **so important** that they understand:

- Students wanting ASU PELL MUST be ADMITTED to ASU FIRST!
- In order to be admitted to ASU, transfer students who have completed 24 or more transferrable hours must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.00.
- The last day to be admitted to ASU for Fall 2009 is August 21, 2009!
- In order to receive ASU financial aid, students are required to take a minimum of 3 credit hours for PELL/6 for PELL with LOAN from ASU EACH semester.
- If the student needs to complete General Education courses, they must be ASU WEB classes or the student must drive to Jonesboro since ASU does NOT bring General Education classes to our campus.
- ASU Fall Registration begins in APRIL and all General Education WEB classes fill quickly. ASU Spring Registration begins in NOVEMBER.
- In order to take ANY junior/senior classes at ANC University Center, the student must declare a major in one of the degrees ASU brings to the ANC campus when applying for admission to ASU. The only exceptions are degrees offered only on the Jonesboro campus that have a FEW courses that MAY be offered on our campus because they are required by degree center degrees.
- There are CORE REQUIREMENTS/PREREQUISITES that are sophomore level courses students MUST have completed PRIOR to enrolling in ASU junior level courses in Education and Business Administration degrees.

ASU ADMISSIONS

- ◆ Complete online application at www.astate.edu
- ◆ Pay \$15 application fee
- ◆ Mail Signature Page that you print at the end of the online application along with the following
 - Official Transcript
 - Shot Record
 - Proof of Selective Service (males 18-25)

Please note that the online application only takes a few minutes to complete; however, it may take ASU several weeks to process your application. Please also know that ASU will NOT process your application until they receive the \$15 application fee, shot record or transcript!! If you do not attend classes the semester you indicated on your application, you will need to call David Kenley, ASU Admissions (800-382-3030) requesting that your entry date be changed. If you do not do this you will have to begin the application process all over again!

 - She processes financial aid paperwork in the order she receives it. **FINANCIAL AID CAN TAKE SEVERAL MONTHS TO BE PROCESSED, SO PLEASE DO NOT WAIT UNTIL THE LAST MINUTE!** Financial aid can be done for the school year (Fall & Spring) in Jan/Feb when you receive your tax information, so please complete and submit financial aid paperwork ASAP!
- ◆ ASU's Financial Aid Code is 001090.
- ◆ ASU's LAST DAY to charge books using financial aid is usually the 2nd day of fall and spring classes. Students cannot charge books during the summer using financial aid.
- ◆ Degree Center and/or dually enrolled students with less than 60 cumulative credit hours should contact the Financial Aid office at the two-year institution they are attending to process their financial aid unless enrolled in the AAS in Nursing Program.

DUALLY ENROLLED STUDENTS

- ◆ Dually enrolled students are students taking both ANC and ASU classes. Dually enrolled students that want their combined enrollment to count for federal aid purposes must to the following to receive ASU financial aid:
 - MUST BE SEEKING AN ASU DEGREE, MUST REGISTER AND MAINTAIN AT LEAST 6 ASU CREDIT HOURS AT ALL TIMES FOR STUDENT LOAN ELIGIBILITY AND MUST PROVIDE A COPY OF ENROLLMENT AFTER THE 11TH DAY OF CLASSES IN ORDER FOR HOURS TAKEN TO COUNT FOR A PELL GRANT. COPIES CAN BE MAILED, FAXED OR SCANNED AS AN ATTACHMENT AND EMAILED TO JESSICA WILSON.**
- ◆ Dually enrolled students need to fill out a deferment form at the ANC Business Office BEFORE classes begin. Failure to do this will result in ANC DROPPING YOU from your ANC classes due to lack of payment. If you fill out the form, you will have approximately 45 days from the day classes begin to pay (for your financial aid check to come in).

ASU ADVISING

You will be assigned an ASU advisor based on which degree you are pursuing. You will have to meet with your advisor EACH SEMESTER BEFORE you will be able to register for classes. Some of our advisors only come to ANC twice a year, so please be aware of this and make plans to meet with your advisor on the day(s) he/she is on our campus!
