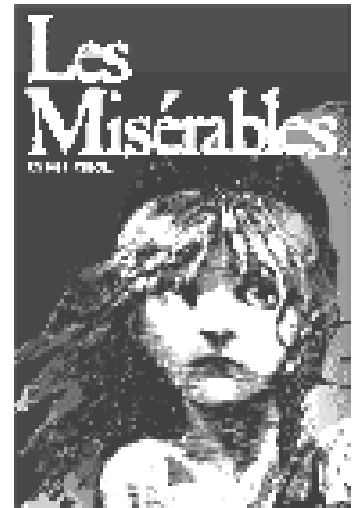

All the while, Valjean is hunted by Javert, a policeman whose lifelong search for Valjean has turned into an obsession.
