



Choral Director/Music Instructor

**POSITION
DESCRIPTION:**

Position is a full-time, standard nine-month appointment to begin August 2017, with potential summer assignments. Successful candidate will teach music appreciation, music theory, and voice; direct choral ensembles; and coordinate and administer choral activities. The choral director responsibilities are compensated with a stipend in addition to the base salary. Duties include teaching a 15-contact hour course load each semester (including day and evening classes), academic advising, assessing for student achievement of learning, serving on college committees, and performing recruitment activities that will expand the choral program.

ANC has an outstanding choral and performing arts program. The ANC choirs have performed at renowned venues such as the Vatican, The Imperial Chapel of the Schonbrunn Palace in Vienna, the Dom Cathedral in Salzburg, the St. Vitus Cathedral in Prague and St. Thomas Church in Leipzig, Germany, and the Basilica of St. Francis of Assisi in Italy as well as many sites throughout the United States such as Carnegie Hall, the Lincoln Center and the Kennedy Center.

ANC has a faculty ranking system which provides the opportunity for promotion to the rank of Assistant Professor, Associate Professor, or Professor based upon years of service, student evaluations, dean evaluations, institutional service, community service, scholarship, student success, and professional development. The ranking system is not a tenure system and does not replace the yearly evaluation.

QUALIFICATIONS: Minimum qualifications include an earned master's degree in choral music. Community college teaching experience is preferred. Qualified applicants must be flexible, exhibit initiative, work closely with all ANC staff and students, and participate in college and community activities. Ability to effectively use available instructional technology is preferred. Applicant selected will be expected to live in Mississippi County, Arkansas.

SALARY: Salary is determined by education and experience as defined on the faculty placement schedule. A generous fringe benefit package is included.
