



Medical Professions Instructor (Part-Time)

POSITION: Position is a part-time position for the Spring, 2017 semester (January – May), working a maximum of 19 hours per week. The Medical Professions Instructor reports directly to the Director of the Technical Center. The ideal candidate should be able to work independently, collaboratively with the full time Medical Professions Instructor, and as part of a team teaching high school students at the ANC Technical Center in Burdette.

QUALIFICATIONS: A professional medical license is required, RN, EMT, Paramedic are a few examples. Candidates with experience in the field of nursing with a working knowledge of emergency medical care and treatment, medical terminology, anatomy and physiology, and medical procedures preferred. Special skills and abilities include the ability to plan teaching strategies around the learning styles of the students; strong communication skills and the ability to have open, receptive interactions with high school students. Class meets Monday-Friday from 10:00 – 11:35 a.m.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Present First Responder curriculum, both theory and hands-on components.
- Present information in curriculum, as well as, develop curriculum independently.
- Plan and execute curriculum as class design.
- Maintain student records.
- Communicate student evaluations and progress to students.
- Collaborate with ANC Technical Center administrative team regularly regarding student records, progress, recruitment, retention and ongoing programs in a proactive approach.
