



Associate Degree Nursing Clinical Instructor (Part-Time)

Position Description:

The clinical instructor in the Associate Degree Nursing Program is a part-time position hired each semester as needed. Clinical instructors are assigned by course in a health care facility providing clinical instruction, supervision, and evaluation to assigned students. Reports to the Director of Associate Degree Nursing and the Dean of Nursing, Allied Health, and HPER.

Qualifications:

Unencumbered licensed as a Registered Nurse in the State of Arkansas or Compact State. Applicant must have Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree. Master's degree in nursing preferred. Minimum of two years of nursing clinical experience.

Job Responsibilities:

Duties of the Associate Degree Nursing Instructor include but are not limited to:

1. Implements the Nursing Department's philosophy of nursing education guided by the College and Nursing Department's mission statement.
2. Follows established academic policies and procedures of the College that facilitate instruction, administration, and student well-being.
3. Provides clinical instruction that supports the learning objectives identified for course assigned.
4. Demonstrates appropriate preparation for clinical instruction, supervision and student evaluation.
5. Develops and maintains an environment conducive to effective learning.
6. Utilizes effective teaching methodologies in clinical setting as appropriate and available to enhance student learning.
7. Evaluates student progress in the clinical lab and clinical facilities and provides written evaluations as requested by the supervisor in a timely manner.
8. Demonstrates effective interpersonal relations and communication skills with students, staff, faculty, and all College employees.
9. Attends and participates in reconvening activities, divisional and departmental faculty meetings as requested.
10. Maintains an annual evaluation portfolio of teaching and professional activities that demonstrates professional growth.
11. Cooperates with other members of the nursing faculty and staff in planning clinical instructional opportunities that meet the course goals and objectives.
12. Responsible for maintaining updated, unencumbered license to practice as a Registered Nurse in Arkansas or from a Compact State.
13. Maintains education and clinical competencies in areas of instructional responsibilities.

Application Deadline:

Review of applicants will begin immediately and will continue until the position is filled. Interviews may occur throughout the application period.
