ANC Ranks #1 in Online Education

Dr. James Shemwell, President of Arkansas Northeastern College (ANC), informed the ANC Board of Trustees recently, that the college had received an honor from AffordableCollegesOnline.com (ACO.) The website recognized ANC as the top college in Arkansas for online degree offerings by two-year colleges. Dr. Shemwell added that ANC had also been named one of the best online colleges in the nation for online delivery.

The website is well-recognized for its higher education information delivery, and how it ranks colleges.

Comparisons of cost and quality are among the measurements used to rank institutions.

Southworth Completes Supervisory Training

It all started with a small idea that turned into great things! Shelly Barley, previous Human Resource Manager at Southworth, wanted to train some of the floor employees to become leaders. Stacey and Shelly met several times to iron out a curriculum and work on writing the grants.

Southworth wanted their employees to make sure they understood "What I say is important, but how I say it will affect: Quality, Productivity, and what it feels like to work here."

The best thing about The Solutions Group is that they can customize training. What's even better is we have the resources to

apply college credit to training, if it meets general requirements. With many ideas and some time to iron out the details with potential instructors, Southworth and The Solutions Group came up with this format:

The format was a bit different than a normal training session, we had two instructors that conducted training twice a week. One was an adjunct instructor that specializes in Leadership Skills, Dr. Jamie Frakes, and the other is our full-time Metallurgical Engineer, Rob Semmel, who also has a strong background in soft skills.

The class was a reflective class, both instructors attended this session and allowed the participants to "run the class." They were tasked with developing a case study that related to their scope of work. The report consisted of pictures and evaluating a potential problem in the workplace and using their training to come up with solutions.

Comments from the participants about this training included:

"I liked the spectrum personality assessment."

"I liked the topics the best."





"Opened my eyes to new ways to use all members of the team and recognize different personalities." "Needs to be a longer course."

The total training hours were 44, which is enough to earn the 12 participants college credit. At the end of the course all 12 participants received 3 hours college credit in Principles of Supervision. By utilizing EWTP and Great River Economic Foundation grants approximately 75% of the total cost of training was paid for leaving Southworth to only pay approximately 25% of the training.

The Arkansas Northeastern College (ANC) Briggs/Sebaugh Wellness Center is available to the community by purchase of a Community Facilities Card.

The Wellness Center Community Facilities Card may be obtained through the ANC Community Education department located at the ANC Main Campus in the Adams/Vines building. Price of the card is \$100 every six months or \$200 annually. If two members of the immediate family (spouse or legal dependent 17 years or older) purchase a card, the second card will be half price or \$50 for six months or \$100 annually.

The discount is limited to one person per family. Cards are purchased for a rolling six month or one year period effective from the date of purchase. Each card will designate the effective and expiration date.





Community card holders must present their Facilities card to the Wellness Center Front Desk and sign-in prior to beginning any fitness activity. The Facilities Card entitles the individual to utilize the following amenities:
